In addition to a day of fun and music, Rock, Reggae & Relief will also raise money for two important initiatives: "Asking for Change" and hurricane relief efforts in Puerto Rico.

With a new hurricane season fast approaching, Puerto Rico remains in a state of emergency nearly one year after Hurricane Maria devastated the island. A portion of proceeds collected during Rock, Reggae & Relief will be donated to Carnegie Mellon University student Rosana Guernica for her upcoming aid trip to Puerto Rico. Rosana and her team have already fundraised over \$200,000, delivered a total of 76,500 lbs. of supplies and evacuated over 200 patients.

Rock, Reggae & Relief is also partnering with the Pittsburgh Downtown Partnership (PDP) and their annual <u>Kid's Play</u> and <u>Night Market</u> events to support "<u>Asking for Change</u>", a social impact campaign aimed at supporting local ministries that provide daily services to homeless families and individuals experiencing crisis in the area.
